Tonight's Flowers

These flowers represent Jesus, the wounded king, as the healer. The pink roses represent grace, and the color pink symbolizes compassion and unconditional love. The new moon shape is symbolic of Maria cradling baby Jesus. The placing of the healing oil within the crown of thorns reminds us that because of his death, we are healed.
