IWS Theses in the Library Catalog

- IWS theses are available by searching the [Library Catalog](#).
- You can search by author and/or title if known ([IWS thesis lists](#) are available on the library website).
- You can also search by subject. To narrow the results of a subject search to IWS theses, simply add "Institute for Worship Studies" to your search.

Locations of Theses in the IWS Library

- Most IWS theses are available in print and electronic format.

- Digital copies are housed on the Populi Library platform and use is restricted to students, staff, faculty, and alumni with Populi/Moodle logins.

- When you find the thesis record you want in the catalog, click on the “online access” link



Login to Populi Library

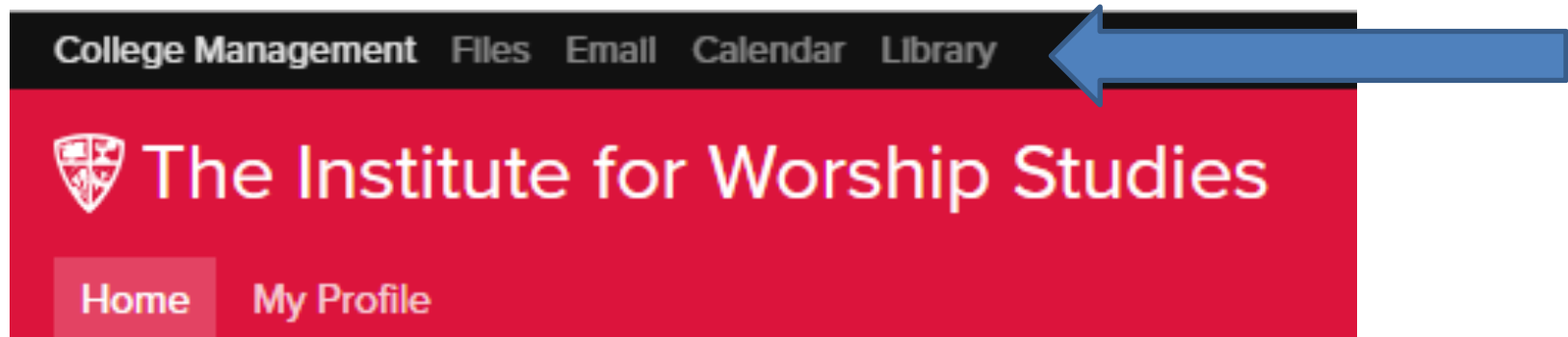
- When you click on the thesis link in the Library Catalog record, a window will open to login to the Populi Library platform
- Login using your Populi/ Moodle User ID and Password and the digital copy of the thesis will open
- If you are already logged in, you will bypass the login window and go straight to the digital copy of the thesis


Using Populi Library to Find Theses

- Search for a thesis by title, author, or subject using the search box


