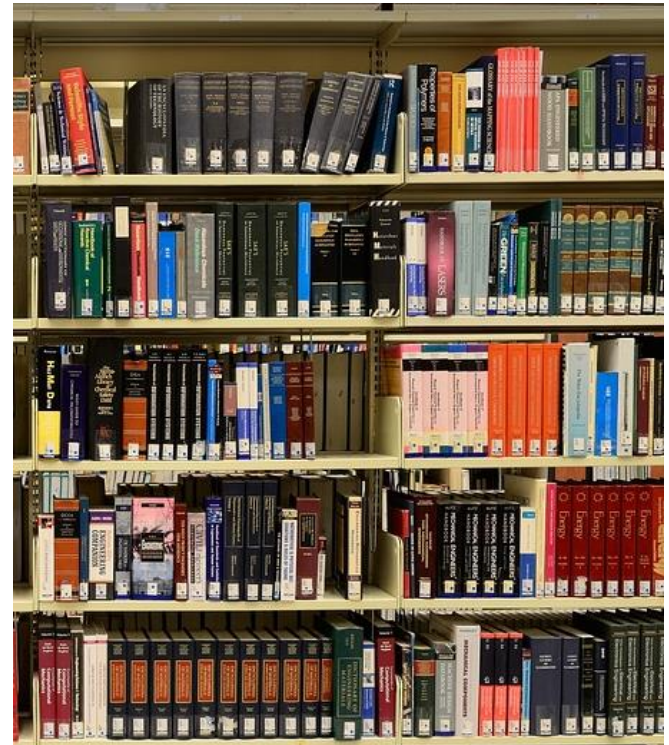
The IWS Library has two addresses: a physical address where the books are located, and a mailing address where books can be mailed to return them.
