Weather

There is no dress code for the on-campus weeks. Jacksonville is chilly in January. Students should dress accordingly and be prepared for occasional inclement weather, as travel between separate buildings on the campus will be required. In the January 2024 on-campus session, we are expecting the daily high temperature to be between 59°F to 73°F (15°C to 22.8°C). On the other hand, daily low temperatures will be between 39°F to 56°F (3.9°C to 13.3°C); however, there may be considerable changes.
