There is no dress code for the on-campus weeks. Jacksonville is hot and humid in June. Students should dress accordingly and be prepared for occasional inclement weather as travel between separate buildings on the campus will be required. In the June 2024 on-campus session, we are expecting the daily high temperature to be between 85°F to 92°F (29.4°C to 33.3°C). On the other hand, daily low temperatures will be between 74°F to 76°F (23.3°C to 24.4°C); however, there may be slight changes. We are also expecting some rain and light showers at some point during the on-campus session.
